Pentathlon GB will be running a National One Day Talent ID Camp on 20th February 2016 to identify new athletes to join the next generation of World Class Talent within Pentathlon GB.

If you meet the eligibility criteria and you are looking for a new challenge, then this could be for you

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In the first instance we are looking for performers that can meet both the physical targets set out in the table below for individual age groups. This will fulfil the set criteria that may make you eligible to access the Great Britain World Class Talent ID Programme for Modern Pentathlon. The most important thing we want to do is offer an opportunity to those talented swimmers and athletes that know they will not quite make the elite programme in swimming and or athletics but could quite possibly meet our standards. Thus enabling you to maybe gain international recognition for the work and preparation dedicated to training over several years.

The process will be for you to check the times below and if you can achieve these in both swim and run then complete the attached form and return it to us at the address shown. You will then be invited to the National Talent ID Camp held at the closest Pentathlon GB Academy to you and undergo some tests, scientifically designed to assess athletes with a view to further confirmation. This will include an introduction to the new laser shooting equipment and one to one question and answer sessions.
